lt's real

Annual global temperatures are 1.9° higher* than preindustrial levels, and the six hottest years ever recorded have all come since 2014.

It's us

For decades, we've burned fossil fuels and released greenhouse gases. This has powered our economy, but it's also the primary cause of rising temperatures.

It's bad

Sea levels are rising. Heat waves are spreading. Wildfires are roaring. Things will get worse. These climate disasters hurt working people first and worst.

We can fix it

We can build a greener, more equitable economy. We can create good, union jobs retrofitting buildings, electrifying transport, and replacing fossil fuels with renewable energy sources.
